



HISTORY OF ST. PETER'S COLLEGE

St. Peter's College, Agra, founded in 1846, is an unaided Christian Minority Institution owned by the Roman Catholic Diocese of Agra Education Society (Under Article 30 (1)), Wazirpura Road, Agra, a registered Charitable and Educational Society and is affiliated to the Council for the Indian School Certificate Examination, New Delhi.

St. Peter's College is one of the oldest institutions of its kind in the country. It began as a Boarding School in 1841 and was transferred to its present building in 1846 which has been accepted as the founding year of the School. The School was affiliated to Calcutta University for its first Entrance Examination, and was hence called a 'College.'

After Independence, the College re-oriented its studies and co-curricular activities to suit the requirements of a free country and a developing society. It has met successfully the new challenges of nation-building and of training the young generation to be better citizens.

The College trains students in Academics, Sports, Games, Cultural and Literary fields, Social and Charitable initiatives, leadership and character formation. As a result of the high reputation of the College, many dignitaries, eminent scholars and statesmen have paid visit to the College. In 1962, The last batch of students appeared for the Senior Cambridge Examination conducted by the Cambridge University and from 1963, the Indian School Certificate Examination was introduced. In 1946 the College celebrated its centenary and in 1996 the sesquicentennial with great fanfare.



To meet the growing need of space, a new block was built in 1963.

A full-fledged building with 33 class rooms, Administrative Block and a Multipurpose Hall was constructed exclusively for primary school in the year 2003 -2004. In 2009, the Multipurpose Block was constructed, inaugurated and blessed.

In 2018 the Main Building was given a major facelift. The small and stuffy class rooms at the back of the Main Building was renovated making room for a three storey building with 24 spacious and well-ventilated class rooms which houses Classes IX to XII and Computer Labs. This renovated Senior Block was blessed on June 29th, 2018.

AIMS AND OBJECTIVES

- 1. To work and serve all in the true Christian spirit of love.
- 2. To reach out and to work with all people of goodwill for the basic values of Truth, Love, Justice, Equality, National Integration and Communal Harmony.
- 3. To educate the children to grow into integrated human beings by helping them to have a proper relationship with God, others and the environment, through spiritual, moral, physical, intellectual and emotional development.
- 4. To inculcate in our students values such as Love, Tolerance, Acceptance, Forgiveness, Justice, sharing and respect for all and to build up a healthy environment.
- 5. To respect all religions and cultures of our country and to strive to achieve 'Unity in Diversity' as part of God's Plan for humanity.

AFFILIATION

The School is recognized by the State Government for providing education to the students up to Class XII and is affiliated to the Council for Indian School Certificate Examination, New Delhi (UP002). It is also recognized by the Inter-state Board for Anglo-Indian Education.

ADMISSION POLICY

- 1. Although a minority institution, we do admit children of different castes and creeds.
- No child of less than five years ten months and more than six years six months will be admitted to Class I. For higher Classes add one year for each Class.
- No pupil will be admitted without a Transfer Certificate from a recognized school last attended except for Class I.
- 4. Students from U.P. Board seeking admission to classes I to IX must have their Transfer Certificates countersigned by the authorities of the Department of Education / Examination Board.
- 5. Admission is given on the basis of Entrance Test, availability of seats and the interaction with the Principal. *For more information log on to www.stpetersagra.org*.

WITHDRAWAL

- 1. The application for Transfer Certificate should be made in writing by the parent or guardian along with a fee and the same will be issued only after minimum three days from the date of receipt of the application.
- 2. A month's notice in writing is required before a student can be withdrawn; in lieu of such a notice, an additional fee of one month should be deposited. No such notice is acceptable during the College vacation; and in case of a withdrawal at this time, the fee must be paid up to the end of the term.
- 3. No certificate will be issued if there are pending dues towards the College.
- 4. Any request for counter-signature should be made at the time of the withdrawal; no such request will be entertained after one month of the issuance of the Transfer Certificate.
- Any student dismissed from the College on disciplinary grounds shall have the same mentioned in his Transfer Certificate.

SYLLABUS

- The Course of study includes Value Education, English, Hindi, Sanskrit, History, Geography, Mathematics, Science, Art, Physical Training, Handi-Craft, Music, Swimming, General Knowledge, and extracurricular activities including yoga.
- Students are to offer only those subjects regularly taught in the College or provided for in the approved scheme of studies.
- 3. If a student does not have 75% attendance of the total working days in each term, he will not be allowed to take the Terminal Examinations.

CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

The School along with academics, equally emphasizes on activities like, Dramatics, Debates (Internal and External), Declamation, Recitation, Kavi Sammelan, Quiz (Science, G.K, Commerce etc.), Drawing, Craft Calligraphy, Wall Newspaper, Bulletin Board, Dance, Singing, Fancy Dress, Photography, Collage Making, Races, March Past, Mass P.T, Drills, Triple Jump, High Jump, Long Jump, Shot-Put, Jevelin, Discus, Tug-of-War, Cycle Race, Relay etc. These activities are conducted throughout the year during Zero periods and on special occasions. The winners are awarded.

STUDENT-SPACE RATIO AND STUDENT-TEACHER RATIO

Our Institution has adequate space per student as well as a good student - teacher ratio. This helps the teacher to focus on each and every student and have a two way interaction between the teacher and the taught which eliminates all hindrances in the way of an effective communication.

MAJOR EVENTS ORGANIZED BY THE SCHOOL THROUGHOUT THE ACADEMIC YEAR

The School organizes Annual Day, Sports Day, Cultural Fest, Cross Country Race, Science-Computer-Commerce Fests, Republic Day-Teacher's Day-Independence Day-Children's Day Celebrations, and various inter and intra school competitions and other events throughout the academic year. We also celebrate religious festivals, with a view to instill in the students respect for all religions. The School also organizes class Picnics, excursions and staff Picnics.

EVENTS AND SEMINARS ORGANIZED FOR TEACHERS

Regular seminars are organised for our teachers on various topics like Managing Behavior Problems in Students, Academic Workshops, OSM Training, Phonics, Phonetic Drills, Stress Management, Capacity Building Programme on Life Skills, Attitudes, Values and Health. These seminars help develop communication skills that make teachers more effective and innovative.
