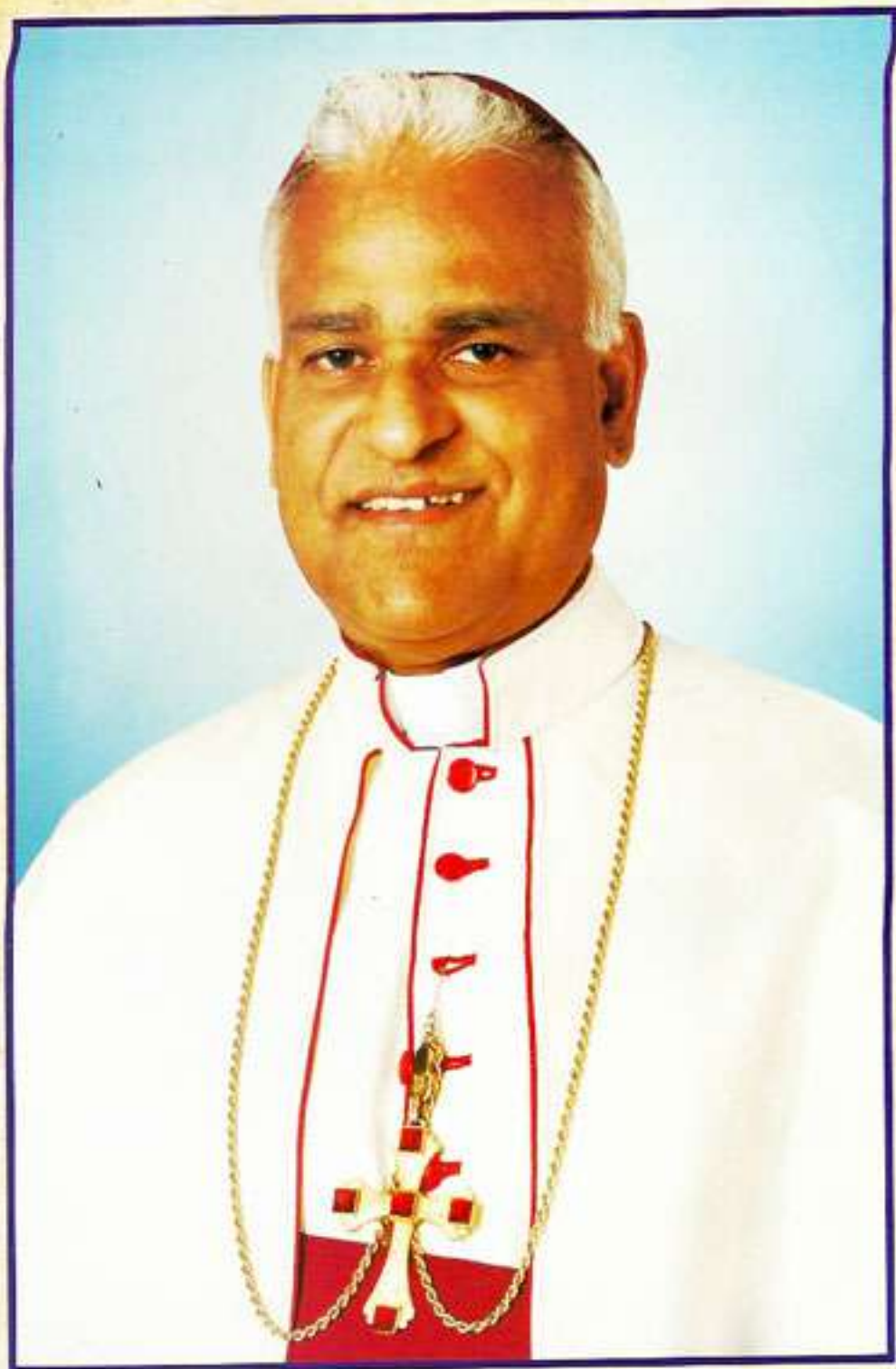

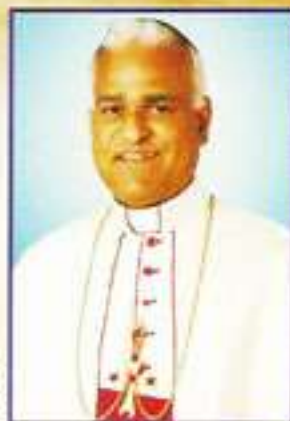

ST. PETER'S COLLEGE BENEFITS FROM YOGA PRINCIPLES

INSTITUTION HAS become a seat of yoga because of Father John Ferreira's 'positive' efforts

Academics apart, 160-year-old St Peter's College is now on a path to carve a unique identity for itself. The college with an imposing building is now known as seat of 'Yoga' with Father John Ferreira being the man behind the success story. It is equipped with sports facility better than the official stadium of Agra.

Thus, it is quite common to hear students singing verses rendered in praise of Father Ferreira while referring him as a healer: "Father if you had not been our principal, we would not have been saved from diseases". It surely conveys the message about a man who was himself known as 'sick man' during his priesthood but is now the healer for thousands of students.

Born in 1951 at Vasai in Mumbai, Father John Ferreira who is presently the principal of the college, is known more as a strong advocate of Yoga.

The college now possesses a Yoga room spread over 8,000 square feet area where Yoga sessions are held regularly. The five-day Youth Enforcement Seminar (YES) conducted by Art of Living of Sri Sri Ravi Shankar Ji concluded on Saturday at the same hall.

It was Father Columban who motivated Father John Ferreira to join priesthood and the Journey began in 1972 at St-Thomas Church at Sandor, Mumbai.

He joined Minor Seminary at Agra and took courses in Philosophy and Theology at St Joseph Seminary, Allahabad. In 1981, he principal of St. Paul's and St principal in 1984 and

He was at St Francis from 1987 to 1994 and later Firozabad from 1994 to 2001 KosiKalan till 2007.

He took charge of St now successfully taking the new heights.

But the things were as he suffered from various trouble, hypertension.

The entire scenario has changed now. The man who used to wear glasses with heavy lenses (-7.2) is now moving without glasses. It all changed after he read a book on 'Surya Namaskar' in 1984 by Satyanand Saraswati from Bihar School of Yoga, Munger.

The book had such an influence on the man that he started imparting Yoga training to others when he travelled to Australia in 1984.

"I found a perfect platform at St. Peter's College of Agra and established a Yoga room spread over 8,000 square feet area and dedicated it to Archbishop," says Father John Ferreira. The college assembly is followed by one-hour session of Yoga.

"Yoga has brought tremendous change in the attitude of my students. They appear to be more positive in approach," he said.

Moreover, the college calendar is also on the theme of Yoga and as months change, the 'asanas' also change with full details therein. It is always a delight to watch Father John Ferreira performing various yogic postures as he is quick and flexible as compared to young boys in college.

ASTRO CLUB

Expert suggests astronomy as subject in the school syllabus



Students, parents and teachers had a date with the stars and the planets at St. Peter's College on Thursday night. As part of the Astro Club initiative, they had gathered there to have a closer view of the heavenly bodies.

The enthusiasm of the spectators pleased Principal of the College Father John Ferreira, the man behind the idea of constituting the Astro Club at this premier institution of the city.

To assist the young astro-aspirants, there was Ajay Talwar, a known astro-photographer who detailed the planets and stars seen through the telescope stationed on the main field of St Peter's College. He advocated astronomy as a subject in the school syllabus.

Star-gazers got to see the ringed planet Saturn. The view of the Moon was clear with prominent craters and streams appearing as zigzag lines drawn in a circled figure. Student members of Astro Club fixed the telescope, which was disturbed by over enthusiastic visitors at the venue and finally found Venus and Mars, much to their delight.

Father John Ferreira said, "This programme has been a real joy and has even taken away the tiredness of constant viewing for two nights. The sky was clearer on Wednesday night but there was better turnout on Thursday night. During day time, we held seminars on astronomy and discussions were held.

Father John Ferreira admitted that enthusiasm was no less amongst parent who too were allowed to be part of the two-day event. He said many of the Astro Club members at St. Peter's College have become members of the World Astro Club through Internet. Father thanked Dr Ratna Shree, Director of Nehru Planetarium, who had inaugurated the Astro Club recently and had been the guiding force behind the project.

Ajay Talwar, well-known astro-photographer from Delhi acknowledged the enthusiasm at the college on Thursday night. Graduate in Hotel Management, Talwar turned to astro photography and now he is manufacturing telescopes and this passion brought him to St. Peter's College.

Ajay recollected his experiment with telescopes when he brought 'raw material' from the flea market and assembled a telescope. He said, "There is always an interest amongst students about stars, planets and the solar system. School authorities should come up with such steps of constituting astro clubs to cater to the inquisitive minds of young students.

Bhavya Kulshrestha, student of St. Pauls' College, was much amazed after watching Saturn and stars in the sky nearer to her eyes. She said, "I have only seen photographs of Saturn in my Geography book and this was for first time that I saw it through the telescope and would remember it for the rest of my life."

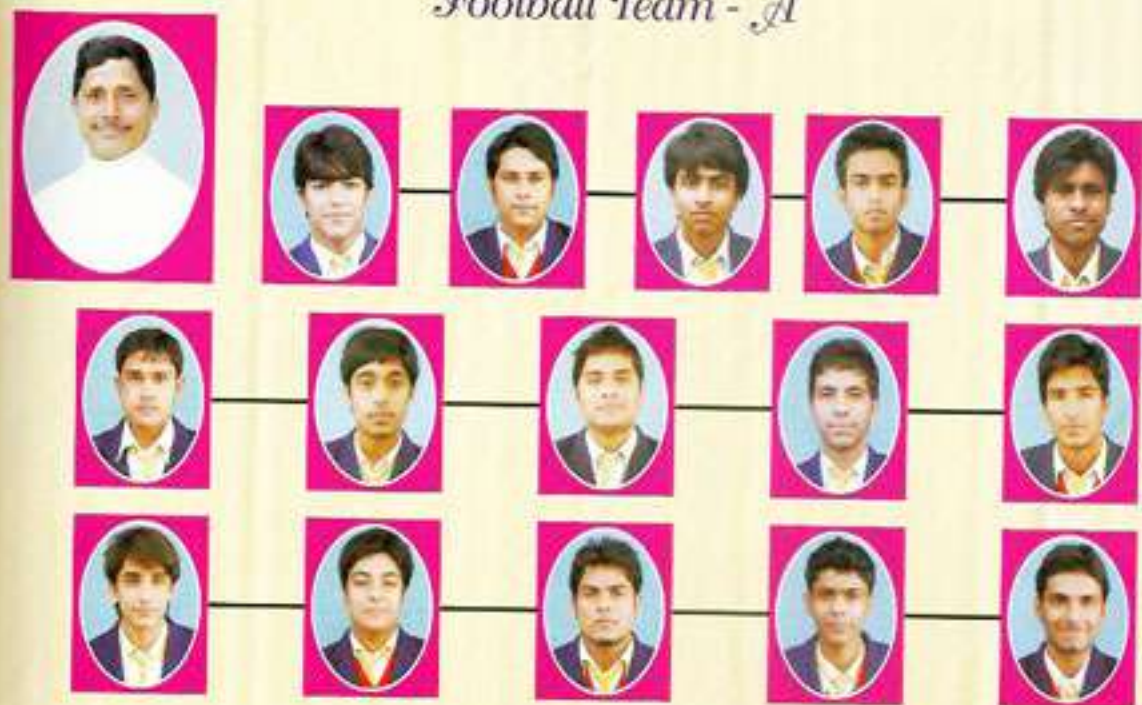

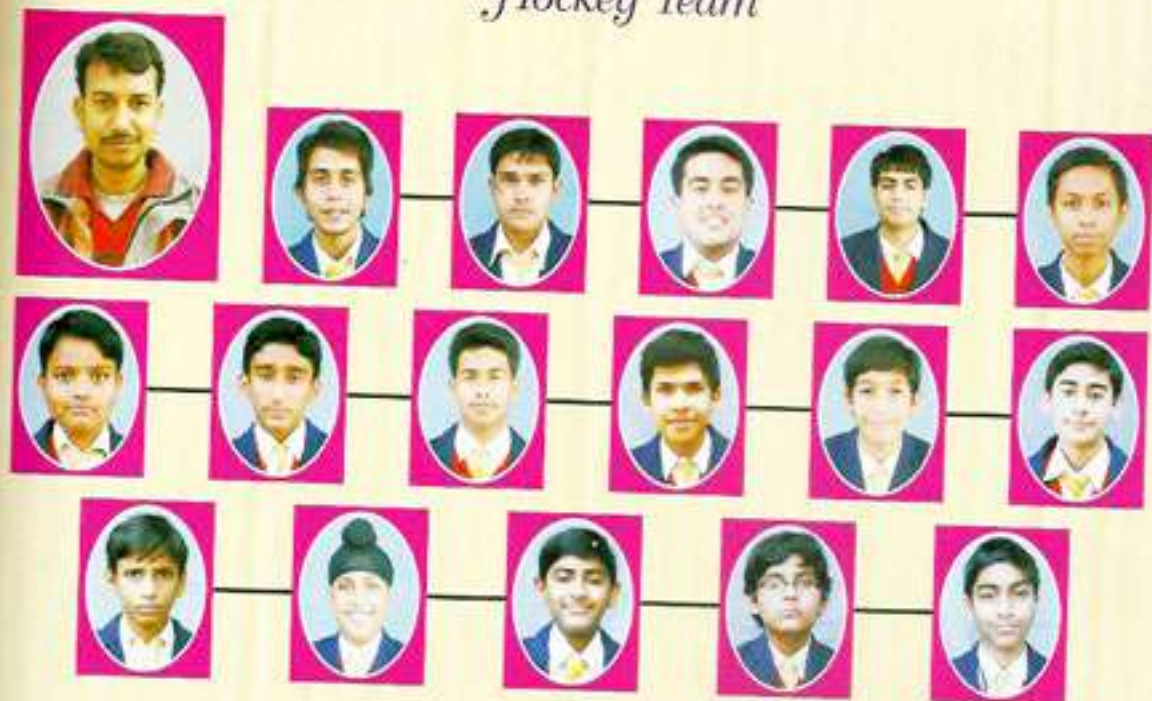
